Deep dangerous pot hole in front of Hungerford House, Seisdon Road, Trysull reported.

Large stones have been exposed at the base of the hedgerow past the Hollybush at Ebtree. Very dangerous and cars have been damaged by these.

Overhanging hedge in front of The Gables, Seisdon Road is forcing vehicles into middle of road when turning left from Seisdon Holloway into Seisdon Road.

Bend sign is covered by the hedge in front of Meadow Cottage, Seisdon Road and cannot be seen.

It was felt that additional road markings/signs are needed to highlight traffic calming areas.

Some signs need attention: Corner Seisdon Road by Meadow Cottage – de-restriction sign is sideways/ Sign at Ebstree Road bridge.

Village Hall - Posts on verge outside Village Hall have been knocked over/damaged.

Highways informed.

Seisdon Road, Trysull - no kerb from the P.C. noticeboard to the Manor House. Highways informed that this is dangerous to pedestrians.

Lights at the Garden Village, Bridgnorth Road, very distracting and Cllr. McCardle stated he has reported this to Enforcement.

Signs on the highway verge outside Wyevale Garden Centre (formerly Gardenland). Highways informed.

Trysull Holloway, village side of bridge, sluice valve tap cast iron cover is broken in the middle of the road. Highways informed.
