Highways did construct the footpath outside the Smithy, Ebstree Road.

Enquired whether new signs have been erected on the playing field.

Parking outside Church, School Road corner, is dangerous. Customers from the Bell also park there. Restricted parking was suggested and Cllr. Mrs. Wilson stated she would put this forward to Highways.

HGV's visiting the landfill site are driving dangerously and some unsheeted. Complaints have been made and VOSA will inspect.

Dog fouling on highway between Fox Road and Post Office Road.

No road sweeper has been along Ebstree Road for several months. To be brought up at the quarry liaison meeting on 27th July 2017.

- 2677 Weight Restriction Request - Seisdon Holloway and Fox Road
County Councillor Mrs. Wilson has visited Seisdon with Mark Keeling to look at where weight restriction signs can be placed. Cllr. Wilson to request confirmation from Mark Keeling that the weight restrictions will go ahead.
- 2683 Noticeboards
Cllr. Neil Compson stated he would have prices for the next meeting. It was reported the noticeboards at the Playing Fields need up-dating.
- 2685 Broken fence, Trysull School
Cllr. Tonkinson will visit the school.
- 2688 Overgrown bush, Seisdon Road (enquiry 4062879
This is to be cut back.
- 2691 New gateway, Monkspath, Bell Road
Planning application has been requested.
- 2692 Gardenland, Bridgnorth Road - accident/signage
Signs require advertisement consent,
- 2695 Woodford Lane
Reply received stating Woodford Lane has been inspected and potholes have been identified.
- 2698 Plantation of trees, Crockington Lane
Simon Griffiths, SCC. has written to the Landowner and this has been re-issued because they have not received a reply.
- 2699 Yew Tree, Green at Seisdon
Cllr. Tonkinson reported he has received complaints about the yew tree on the green at Seisdon as the branches are hanging over the footpath. Mr. Dore has been notified and is to inspect. Cllr. McCardle is meeting Mr. Dore and will enquire about the yew tree and the trees along School Road bordering the School.
- 2700 Lengthsman
Cllr. Compson felt that volunteers carrying out work should be considered. It was suggested a list should be made of areas where work is required.
- 2701 2 Bell Road
Planning Enforcement dealing with this.
- 2702 Highway grass cutting, Ebtree Road
Andy Cousins will look into this.
- 2703 Fox Road, car parking
Parked cars to be monitored.
- 2704 Hollybush, Ebtree Road
Hollybush is now open.

- 2705 Unathorised residential use, Church Lane
Planning application has been requested by the Planning Authority. Cllr. McCardle is following this up.

- 2706 The Old Smithy - Plaque Turner Sports Cars
Residents of the Old Smithy interested in possibility of a plaque being erected. Chairman will research this.

- 2707 Drone
This has been reported to the Police.

- 2708 Traffic Lights, Fox Road/Bridgnorth Road junction
County Councillor Mrs. Wilson discussed this with Mark Keeling and idea rejected because of excessive costs. C.Cllr. Mrs. Wilson stated she would ask Mark for a breakdown of these costs and the Chairman stated there have been two fatalities and a case in favour of traffic lights should be considered.

- 2709 Grass verge in front of former Seven Stars
Maintained by South Staffs. This has been cut.

Pavement Engineer to assess footway and put it forward to a Structural Maintenance programme.

The Smithy, Seisdon - If the elected member is prepared to fund knowing the issues with the adjoining property, the owner of the property can be contacted regarding consent.

Wombourne Road (4014672) Replacing bollards remains low priority.

Wombourne Road - Village entrance sign has been added to County Councillor's list.

Woodford Road, Trysull (Enquiry 40446 25) Pot holes reported. Site has been assessed.

Union Lane - blocked gully outside Awbridge Cottage reported to Highways Hotline.

Womboune Road (Enquiry 4060863)Trees and hedges overhanging Wombourne Road from Bratch Farm to Union Lane need to be cut back to prevent damage to vehicles and assist visibility.

Overgrown hedge, Trysull Holloway (Enquiry 4060859)

Post Office Road (Enquiry 4064667) Two large potholes outside Nurseries. Site assessed.

Fox Road (Enquiry 4062441) Damage to highway verges.

Ebtree Road (Enquiry 4064671)Deep ruts in carriageway from Trysull Holloway to Seisdon Quarry.

Hedge, Feiashill Road - Cllr. Compson will visit and ask for overgrown hedge to be cut back.

Dimingsdale Bridge (Enquiry 4083806) Potholes opposite bus stop.

Fox Close and The Green (Enquiry 4083810) Weeds growing through payment on Fox Road.
