NEW HIGHWAY MATTERS

It was reported the lights at the end of the Pavilion Garden Centre are too low and blind motorists as the travel along Bridgnorth Road. Extremely dangerous and the Clerk to report this to SSC Enforcement Team.

Large pothole on left hand side of Feiashill Road when travelling out of Trysull, opposite the former Heather Nursery. Clerk to report to Highways.

ANY NEW BUSINESS

Cllr. Kelly has reported flytipping in Union Lane at Bell Road end and at entrance to Workhouse to the Enforcement Team at SSC.

It was reported District Councillor Bob McCardle is still unwell and the Clerk reported a card has been sent to him.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

A member of the public was concerned about the broken bollard on Ebstree Road and offered to take this out as it is dangerous and a tripping hazard. Cllr. Tonkinson stated he has a bollard and the resident will collect this and replace the broken bollard.

It was reported the drain outside the Village Hall is scheduled to be cleaned.

It was reported HGV's are continuing to travel along Seisdon Road. The Police continue to monitor when resources allow.

It was reported cyclists from a Club were riding in a dangerous manner along Post Office Road. 4 or 5 abreast. The resident will forward details to the Chairman.

COUNTY COUNCILLOR'S REPORT

C.Cllr. Mrs. Wilson reported the County Council is receiving £19 million from the Government. The County Council should be back in credit by 2023/24.

C.Cllr. Mrs. Wilson reported her meeting with a resident and her response.

Cllr. Neil Compson reported he has investigated the replacement of old signs on the Playing Fields and has a quote of £30.00 plus VAT per sign and there are 5 signs. Cllr. Compson will update the new signs and include no drone flying. It was agreed Cllr. Neil Compson go ahead and order signs. Vice Chairman felt the benches could be renovated.
