Site allocation – gypsy, traveller and travelling showpeople consultation

Residents attended the meeting to express concerns regarding Church Lane's inclusion in the Site Allocation document. Cllr. McCardle explained the procedure of this consultation and the Chairman assured the meeting that the Parish Council will be objecting to the inclusion of land off Church Lane as a potential gypsy and traveller site.

14/00808/FUL Proposed single storey extens., alterations and external swimming pool, Wilderhope, Tinkers Castle Road - Objections, overdevelopment in the Green Belt.

14/00925/TREE Fell tulip tree, Hungerford, Seisdon Road – no objections

Appeal – British Legion Club, Seisdon Rd. – obj. Inappropriate development in Green Belt.

Site Allocation G29 Church Lane, Seisdon - Object on green belt, no school, no bus service, no services, no post office (only one small store and garage) access unsuitable, narrow single track.

Wooden building at the Mill House, Seisdon – Enforcement action being taken.

Garage at the Mill House – our comments have been logged and will be investigated.
