**MINUTES OF MEETING**

The Minutes of Meeting dated 8<sup>th</sup> September 2004, and Planning meetings dated 16<sup>th</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2004 were agreed and signed as a true record.

**PLANNING APPLICATIONS**

04/01185/FUL Replacement garage, extended kitchen and lounge with new bedroom and bathroom over, 171 Post Office Road, Seisdon - No objection. Vice Chair declared an interest.

04/01146/FUL Detached industrial office block, Smestow Bridge Industrial Estate – No objections

04/01162/FUL Demolition of existing derelict storage sheds and erection of new stables, 2 Clan Park Farm, Trysull - No objection

04/00222/FUL Amended plans for demolition of cottages and construction of 1 dwelling with detached 3 car garage, Home Farm Cottages, Crockington Lane, Seisdon - Strong objections on grounds of inappropriate development in the Green Belt. The proposed dwelling is too large and it is felt that cottages such as these should be retained in their present position. Plans not complete as there was no existing elevation plan and no block plan.

Mr. Unwin reported that the tarmac between Ebstree Road bridge and the bus shelter is breaking away and the Clerk was given a map to forward to the Highways Dept. requesting repair of this area.

The Chairman stated he has been informed that children are becoming a nuisance on the green area by Fox Close, Seisdon. It was reported that a sign prohibiting games used to be on this green and it was felt a sign similar to this would be helpful. The Clerk was asked to write to the relevant Authority.

The Chairman stated he would be attending the Remembrance Service at the Staffordshire Council Offices on 11<sup>th</sup> November and it was agreed the Chairman should purchase a wreath.
