Seisdon Road, Seisdon - by green telephone terminal, at junction with Ebstree Road , 4 or 5 hawthorn trees are dangerous. Highways informed.

Seisdon Road, Trysull - no kerb from the noticeboard to the Manor House. Highways informed that this is dangerous to pedestrians.

Trysull Holloway /Ebstree Road - cannot see traffic to the right because of the overgrown hedge. Clerk has informed landowner.

Seisdon Road - bushes by bus shelter are overgrown. Clerk to pass on Vice Chairman's e-mail address to Andy Cousins, S.S.C, to arrange site meeting.

E-mail from Simon Griffiths regarding visit of NHT team on 7th October. Jobs to include:

- (i) Cut back hedge by Fox Road build out to expose 30mph sign and also priority to oncoming traffic.
- (ii) Vegetation at bridge on Ebstree Road to be cut back to expose signs.
- (iii) Cutting back vegetation from metal fences.
