The Chairman opened the meeting and informed those present that this meeting has been held to discuss two planning applications relating to Seisdon Quarry as follows:

SS.15/13/627 M D5 Submission of details in compliance with Condition 33 of Planning permission SS15/13/627 M relating to a 6 month progress report (fourth review) at Seisdon Quarry, Ebstree Road, Seisdon

This application proposes to continue extraction beyond 30th June 2018. Extraction will provide remaining mineral production for 2018 which has been delayed by weather conditions. This is in question as it was reported progress was being made in line with the consented scheme at the January 2018 Liaison Meeting and a lot of the winter weather had already been experienced. The Chairman stated the Parish Council are unanimously opposed to any extension of time for the winning and working of sand and gravel at Seisdon Quarry. Members of the public expressed their views and objections.

It was agreed objections will be forwarded to Staffordshire County Council on the grounds of size of lorries, which have increased over the last few months, health and safety of residents, lorries must access and exit in a northerly direction towards Lower Penn, danger to residents, cyclists and motorists.

SS.15/13/627 M NMA1 Non material amendment relating to Condition 11 of Planning Permission SS.15/13/627 M at Seisdon Quarry, Seisdon

It was reported that the application form states 'alternatively the MPA may choose to remove Condition 11 entirely as the 'controlling' conditions in relation to the timings of working and restoration relate to Conditions 3 and 33'. The Parish Council are totally opposed to this application.
