NEW HIGHWAY MATTERS

Cllr. Harrison informed the meeting that the bridge in Post Office Road, over the Mill Stream has a collapsed arch and needs an urgent inspection. Clerk to inform Bridges Department at Stafford.

Cllr. Mrs. Clarke stated that a bush overhangs Ebtree Road from Beech Hurst Farm blocking visibility to the left when coming out of Post Office Road. Mrs. Lui, a resident of Seisdon present at the meeting, offered to speak to the gardener and request this be cut back. Cllr. Compson thanked Mrs. Lui for her assistance.

Cllr. Kelly reported a blocked gully outside Awbridge Cottage, Union Lane, Trysull. Clerk to report this to Highways.

ANY NEW BUSINESS

Cllr. Harrison expressed concern about the overall look of the Parish with many places weedy and untidy. Cllr. Harrison suggested small working parties to undertake weed spraying etc. and offered to tidy up the area around the first bridge in Post Office Road, Seisdon.

Cllr. Compson stated he would be looking into noticeboard prices.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Mr. John Bishop expressed concerns regarding the quarry end date being stated as December 2019 and not 2018 as originally thought.

Play Area

E-mail received from Veolia Environmental Trust stating the Parish Council have been unsuccessful in obtaining grant aid for the new Play Area. Sub-committee to meet to discuss what work can be carried out with the funds we hold to put the Play Area back into use.

Cllr.Kelly reported on repairs which need to be carried out to the Hall.
- 1795 Neighbourhood Watch
PCSO Louise Jones gave her report of crime in the Parish. Louise is moving on and Cllr. Compson thanked her for her assistance as our PCSO..
- 1796 Trysull School – 20 mph zone
Awaiting Invoice from Mark Keeling.
- 2205 Seisdon quarry
Nothing further to report.
- 2242 Wolverhampton Business Airport
Reports forwarded to Councillors. Cllr. Harrison reported that aircraft traffic has not changed. District Cllr. McCardle stated he will be having a meeting with the owners of the site.
- 2634 Landfill Site
Nothing further to report.
- 2642 Fly tipping
Please ring 01902 696200 to report incidents of fly tipping. Cllr. Kelly stated there is constant flytipping in Union Lane, Flash Lane and Blackpitt Lane although this is collected promptly when reported. Fridges have been tipped on private land adjacent to the Landfill site.
- 2650 Lorry sign at Post Office Road
Cllr. Edwards has been asked to consider providing this sign from his DPP allocation.
- 2652 Extend footpath, The Smithy
This request can be listed for consideration under the local members divisional highway programme.
- 2654 Stencilling dog signs
Cllr. Neil Compson informed the meeting he has stencilled signs in both Parishes although it was felt there was little improvement in dog fouling.
- 2658 Drains, Ebstree Road
Gullies have been cleaned on Trysull Holloway. Continue to wait for gullies on Ebstree Road to be cleaned.
- 2660 SID sign on Ebstree Road
It was felt the SID signs need to be installed further along Seisdon Holloway, left hand side travelling towards the village by Lanes Farm, especially in view of horses exiting and entering the stables. Clerk to inform Mark Keeling.
- 2661 Community Car Park
Clerk to request a new grit bin later in the year. Awaiting reply from Trysull & Seisdon Charity regarding the Lease.
- 2665 Weight Restriction warning signs
Reply received from Simon Griffiths, Highways, stating this will need to be funded and considered via the Local Members Divisional Highway Programme.

- 2667 Rural Crime Initiative
Cllr. Compson reported that Maggie Quinn has submitted a funding bid for forensic marking in the Parish. Cllr. Compson has obtained names and addresses supporting this application.

Oak Drive payment

Pavement Engineer to assess footway and put it forward to a Structural Maintenance programme. E-mail and photographs received regarding bad state of the footpath. Awaiting reply from Mark Keeling regarding Clerk's request for an update.

The Smithy, Seisdon - Awaiting result of discussions with the new owners and Highways.

Wombourne Road (4014672) Bollards broken on bend between Union Lane and Ovens End.

Wombourne Road - Village entrance sign has been added to Cllr. Edwards' DHP for future consideration.

Fox Road - hedge on right hand side by traffic calming when approaching from Bridgnorth Road still needs to be cut back more severely in order to see oncoming traffic.

Post Office Road, manhole cover outside Lilac Cottage, Post Office Road where the tarmac is crumbling and coming away making the manhole cover unstable. Clerk has informed Highways.

Woodford Road, Trysull (Enquiry 40446 25) Pot holes reported. Site has been assessed.

Union Lane, Trysull (Enquiry 4044624) Pot holes outside Awbridge Farm, Flash Lane and Blackpit Lane. Site has been assessed.

Ebstree Road - 'give way' sign missing by the Smithy. This has been reported.
